Two year old Charlie Stephens was flown from North Platte to Children's Hospital in Omaha late September 26,2015. Her parents were informed Sunday September 27 that their little girl had Leukemia, they performed a bone biopsy that day to determine the type. She was diagnosed with Pre-B Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. She started treatment the very next day. She has completed three phases and is in her fourth. She has had the following treatment: 8 lumbar punctures with chemo, many IV doses of chemo, steroids for 28 days of induction and just finished a 7 day pulse, 2 doses of a hour long chemo drip, an oral chemo for 28 days, and she receives a hour long antibiotic IV drip to prevent pneumonia every four weeks. She will continue chemo treatments through IV, procedures, and oral medications until November 2017. Charlie and her mom, Michelle, have been and will continue to travel to and from Omaha for these treatments. Michelle has yet to return to work. This benefit is to help the family with the many expenses they will continue to incur during Charlie's journey.
