







Rotary is dedicated to causes that build international relationships, improve lives, and create a better world to support our peace efforts and end polio forever.

### Our Causes















Rotary's programs are developing the next generation of leaders, providing funding to make the world a better place, and making peace a priority. And our programs are not just for club members. Learn how you can make a difference in your community through Rotary.





#### **Rotary Peace Fellowships**

Each year, Rotary selects up to 130 professionals from around the world to receive fully funded academic fellowships at our Rotary Peace Centers.



#### **Rotary Community Corps**

Finding community solutions to community challenges, Rotary Community Corps unites Rotary members with nonmembers to make a positive difference.



#### Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)

RYLA is a leadership development program for young people who want to learn new skills, build their confidence, and have fun. Events range from one-day seminars to weeklong camps.







Rotary Youth Exchange builds peace one young person at a time. Students learn a new language, discover another culture, and truly become global citizens.



#### Grants

For 100 years, The Rotary Foundation has been turning project ideas into reality. Our clubs receive funding to support humanitarian projects, scholarships, and international exchanges.



#### Scholarships
